## EXPLANATORY NOTES

**Goat Health Statement** – Under the *Stock Diseases Act 1923*, this form is a Health Statement for Johne’s Disease provided sections 1, 2, 3, 5, 7 and 9 are completed, and a Health Statement for Footrot provided sections 1, 2, 3, 5 and 6 are completed.

**Transported Stock Statement** – this form is not yet approved as a Transported Stock Statement (TSS) under section 140J of the *Rural Land Protection Act 1998*.

**Free of footrot** – means not infected with Virulent Footrot. Any condition that resembles footrot must be assessed by a veterinarian or an Inspector of Stock before it is classified as not being virulent footrot.

**Herd or property of origin** – herd or property from which goats are being consigned.

<sup>a</sup> **Infected** – means infected with Johne’s disease. Herds are no longer regarded as infected when a Property Disease Management Program that has been approved by the CVO of the jurisdiction, has been completed.

<sup>b</sup> **BJD control or residual zone** – BJD zones have been agreed nationally. Details are available from your District Veterinarian or [www.dpi.nsw.gov.au](http://www.dpi.nsw.gov.au).

<sup>c</sup> **Approved Property Disease Management Program** – a program to manage the risk of Johne’s disease, that has been approved by the CVO of the jurisdiction.

<sup>d</sup> **Negative approved test** – test of 50 representative goats over one year of age (or all goats over one year of age in small herds) by serology, faecal culture or pooled faecal culture (when approved for use in goats), with negative results.

<sup>e</sup> **PFC 350 test** – test of a 350 representative sheep over 2 years of age (or all sheep over 2 years of age in small flocks) by pooled faecal culture in pools of up to 50 sheep.

<sup>f</sup> **Eligible for Abattoir 700 status** – 700 representative sheep over 2 years of age have been submitted to an abattoir in the past 24 months with at least 500 sheep, in 1 or more lots, being examined and found negative for OJD.

<sup>g</sup> **Vaccinated with Gudair<sup>®</sup> vaccine** – goats that have been vaccinated according to manufacturer’s recommendations and subject to any conditions defined by the CVO of the jurisdiction.

<sup>h</sup> **Approved goat-rearing program** – an industry recognised goat-rearing program to minimise disease spread, that has been documented and approved by the CVO of the jurisdiction.
