Charter Fishing Boat Licence Transfer Conditions

- 1. Subject to Approval:** Charter Fishing Boat Licences may be transferred only if approved. It should not be assumed that transfer approval will be automatic on application.
- 2. Some Licences are not Transferable:** Only *transferable* charter fishing boat licences may be transferred.
- 3. Dual Activity:** NSW Department of Primary Industries will not approve a transfer if it will create a situation where the boat is licensed for both commercial fishing and charter fishing (dual licensed). It should also be noted that dual licences may not be transferred. If the boat is currently licensed for both commercial fishing and charter fishing, only one of the licences may be transferred to each new party.
- 4. Entitlements:** By signing this application each party accepts that any authorisations, entitlements, endorsements or history of operations associated with the licence are transferred to the transferee on approval of the application.
- 5. Third Party Review:** Transfer of a Charter Fishing Boat Licence does not preclude the licence from a review under clause 313 of the *Fisheries Management (General) Regulation 2002*.
- 6. Licence must be in force:** The use of a boat for guided recreational charter fishing is authorised when a licence for that boat is in force. Licences may be cancelled or suspended by notice in writing.
- 7. Licence Conditions:** A charter fishing boat licence is subject to the conditions prescribed in the *Fisheries Management (General) Regulation 2002* and to any further conditions specified in the licence.
- 8. Boat Capacity:** The transferee understands that the fishing capacity of the boat cannot exceed the carrying capacity (as at 4 August 1999) of the boat relied on to satisfy the eligibility criteria for the licence. Any breach of this condition may lead to the suspension or cancellation of the licence.
- 9. Marine Parks:** The transferee understands that holding a charter fishing boat licence to operate in NSW coastal waters does not automatically allow the boat to operate in a Marine Park. - 10. Recreational Fishing Fee Exemption Certificate:** Are non-transferable. Inquiries concerning application for an Exemption Certificate can be made to the Recreational Licensing Unit on (02) 9527 8585.

- The original Charter Fishing Boat licence (if current) to be returned (attach to application).
- All recreational fishing logbooks and completed returns to be returned/attached
- The original Recreational Fishing Licence Exemption Certificate (if current/issued) to be returned
(attach to application)
- A copy of the vessels NSW Maritime Authority Certificate(s) of Survey, or NSW Maritime Authority Certificate(s) of Recognition & Interstate Certificate(s) of Survey (if applicable) be forwarded with this application
- A completed Application for Boat Replacement for a Licensed Charter Fishing Boat form if the transferee intends to operate a different vessel also be submitted
