STOCK DISEASES ACT 1923—PROCLAMATION No. 502

RESTRICTIONS ON THE INTRODUCTION OF PIGS INTO NEW SOUTH WALES FROM QUEENSLAND,
WESTERN AUSTRALIA AND THE NORTHERN TERRITORY

(L.S.) J. A. ROWLAND, *Governor*.

I, Air Marshal Sir JAMES ANTHONY ROWLAND, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of the provisions of section 11B of the Stock Diseases Act 1923, do hereby revoke Stock Diseases Proclamation No. 465 published in Government Gazette No. 114 of 19th August, 1983 restricting the introduction of pigs into New South Wales from Queensland, Victoria, South Australia, Western Australia, Tasmania, the Northern Territory and the Australian Capital Territory, and whereas I am of the opinion that the introduction of pigs into New South Wales from Queensland and those parts of Western Australia and the Northern Territory north of the Tropic of Capricorn is likely to introduce a certain disease of pigs, namely, *Brucella suis* Infection: Now therefore I do, with the advice of the Executive Council and in pursuance of the Stock Diseases Act 1923, hereby restrict the introduction of pigs from those States and Territory in the following manner:

No person shall introduce or permit to be introduced any pig into New South Wales from Queensland or from north of the Tropic of Capricorn in Western Australia or the Northern Territory unless the pig is from a herd not known to be infected with *Brucella suis* and

1. (a) is being consigned directly to an abattoir for slaughter within 7 days, or
(b) has first been tested for *Brucella suis* with negative results within 30 days immediately preceding introduction into New South Wales; or
(c) is from an accredited brucellosis free herd or from a herd approved by the Chief, Division of Animal Health.
2. (a) At the time of introduction there shall be presented to an Inspector at or nearest the place of introduction, a declaration made by the person having possession of the stock at the time and a certificate signed by a Veterinary Officer or Inspector of Stock for the State or Territory from which the stock is being introduced in or to the effect of Schedule 1 hereto.
(b) Any certificate signed by a Veterinary Officer or Inspector of Stock pursuant to this Proclamation shall be invalid unless movement of the stock related thereto commences within 14 days of the date of certification.

In this Proclamation:

Definitions

“Tested for *Brucella suis*” means tested by the Serum Agglutination Test or any other test approved by the Chief, Division of Animal Health, at a laboratory approved by the Chief Veterinary Officer of the State or Territory concerned and each and every animal in the consignment to be moved is tested with negative results.

“Accredited Brucellosis Free Herd” means a herd registered in a Brucellosis Free Herd Scheme approved by the Chief Veterinary Officer of the State or Territory concerned.
