

PLANT DISEASES ACT 1924

Notification of Quarantine Area (Fruit Fly)

New South Wales Fruit Fly Exclusion Zone
andOrder prohibiting the introduction of Fruit Fly
susceptible Fruit

I, IAN R. CAUSLEY, Minister for Agriculture and Fisheries,
HEREBY DECLARE the following land to be a Quarantine
Area on account of the presence of the pest, fruit fly (family
Tephritidae):

QUARANTINE AREA

known as the
New South Wales Fruit Fly Exclusion Zone

All that land generally south of a line commencing at
the South Australia — New South Wales border, to the
northernmost portions of the town of Silverton, thence to
Stephens Creek 16 km north of Broken Hill, thence in a
line direct to the northernmost boundary of Bakala
Lake, thence to the easternmost boundary, thence to to a
point on the Menindee — Sydney railway line 30 km from
Menindee, thence south to a point 10 km south, and in a
line remaining 10 km south of the Menindee — Sydney
railway line until that line meets the western boundary of
the Carrathool Shire; and including:

All land within the Shires of Carrathool, Narrandera,
Griffith City, Leeton, Urana, Corowa, Berrigan,
Jerilderie, Murrumbidgee, Conargo, Windouran, Hay,
Balranald, Wentworth, Municipality of Deliniquin,
Berrigan, Murray and Wakool; and including:

All land in a line along the Murray River from the
eastern boundary of the Corowa Shire to the South
Australian border, and thence north along the South
Australian — New South Wales border to the point of
commencement.

I HEREBY ORDER that:

no person shall introduce into the New South Wales Fruit Fly
Exclusion Zone (or have possession in the Zone) of the
following fruit:

- (a) fruit not produced within the Quarantine Area; or
- (b) fruit susceptible to Fruit Fly (including fruit
particularised in the Schedule).

This Order does not restrict the introduction into the
quarantine area or possession of fruit in the Quarantine
Area or a part of the Quarantine area where the
introduction or possession is in compliance with an Order
or exemption permitting such introduction or possession.

The Chief, Division of Plant Industries may in writing
exempt any specified fruit on conditions stated in the
exemption from the provisions of this Direction.

THE SCHEDULE

N14
FRUIT SUSCEPTIBLE TO FRUIT FLY

which may not be brought into the New South Wales
Fruit Fly Exclusion Zone

All citrus fruits:

including citron, grapefruit, kumquat (japonica) (margarita);
lemon (Meyer) (Tanaka); lime (all species, including West
Indian, Tahitian, Rangpur), mandarin (blanco), orange (all
varieties including Seville or sour, and sweet), pummelo,
shaddock, tangelo, tangor.

All pome fruit:

including apple, nashi, pear, quince.

All stone fruit:

including apricot, cherry, nectarine, peacharine, peach, plum,
plumcot.

All tropical fruits:

including avocado, banana, breadfruit, caimito (star apple),
carambola (starfruit), casimiroa (white sapote), custard apple,
durian, guava (of all types) (myrtaceae) (strawberry) (yellow
cattley), jabotica, jackfruit, longan, lychee, mango,
mangosteen, papaya, passionfruit, pawpaw, rambutan,
sapodilla, black sapote, soursop, sweetsop (sugar apple).

The following berry fruit:

blackberry, boysenberry, loganberry, raspberry, youngberry,
blueberry, mulberry, strawberry, cape gooseberry.

The following fruit:

abi, Brasilian cherry, capsicum, cashew apple, cherimoya,
chili (chillies) (cherry peppers) (tabasco), Coffee berry
(Arabian coffee) (arabica) (canephora) (Excelsa) (Liberian)
(Robusta), Dates (fresh), eggplant, feijoa, fig, jujubes,
granadilla, grumichama, (Brazilian) (Costa Rican); kiwifruit
or Chinese gooseberries, loquat, medlars, pepino, persimmon,
prickly pear, rollinia, santol, tamarillo, tomato, walnuts
(green), Wax jambu, babaco, pomegranate.
