Lower jaw samples

If you harvested a fallow deer, you are required to remove and send the lower jaw of each fallow harvested to NSW DPI.

Refer to the *How to identify harvestable fallow deer in NSW Ecological Deer Management Forests and jaw extraction guide*, supplied with your EDM kit.

Lower jawbones must be cleaned and boiled prior to sending, penalties apply for non-compliance.

Sterile gloves and two plastic zip lock bags are supplied with your EDM kit for use when removing a jawbone.

- ➔ Place the jaw in the first zip lock bag.
- ➔ Place the first zip lock bag and this EDM Harvest Return form together inside the second zip lock bag.

➔ **If you harvested a deer:**

- **drop** the jawbone and harvest return form in the EDM jaw box located on the Hopetoun Park Access Road entrance to Maragle South State Forest, or
- **mail** the jawbone and harvest return, to the Wildlife Management Team, Game Licensing Unit, 620 Macauley Street, Albury NSW 2640.

➔ **If you did not harvest a deer:**

- **drop** the harvest return form in the EDM jaw box located on the Hopetoun Park Access Road entrance to Maragle South State Forest, or
- **mail** the form to the Wildlife Management Team, Game Licensing Unit, PO Box 3415, Albury NSW 2640, or
