PLANT DISEASES ACT 1924**PROCLAMATION [P117]**

Proclamation to Declare Red Imported Fire Ant to be a
Pest for the Purposes of the Plant Diseases Act 1924

HER Excellency Professor MARIE BASHIR AC,
Governor.

I, Professor MARIE BASHIR AC, Governor of the State of
New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council,
declare:

1. in pursuance of section 28B (c) of the Plant Diseases
Act 1924, Red Imported Fire Ant [*Solenopsis invicta*]
to be a pest for the purposes of the Act; and
2. in pursuance of section 10 (2) of the Plant Diseases Act
1924, that section 10 of the Plant Diseases Act 1924
applies in respect of the pest Red Imported Fire Ant
[*Solenopsis invicta*].

Notes:

- (i) Section 10 (1) of the Plant Diseases Act 1924 requires
occupiers of land in which any pest (in respect of
which section 10 applies) appears to give written
notice, within 24 hours after first discovering or
becoming aware of the pest's appearance, of the
appearance of the pest to an inspector or the Director
General of the Department of Agriculture.
