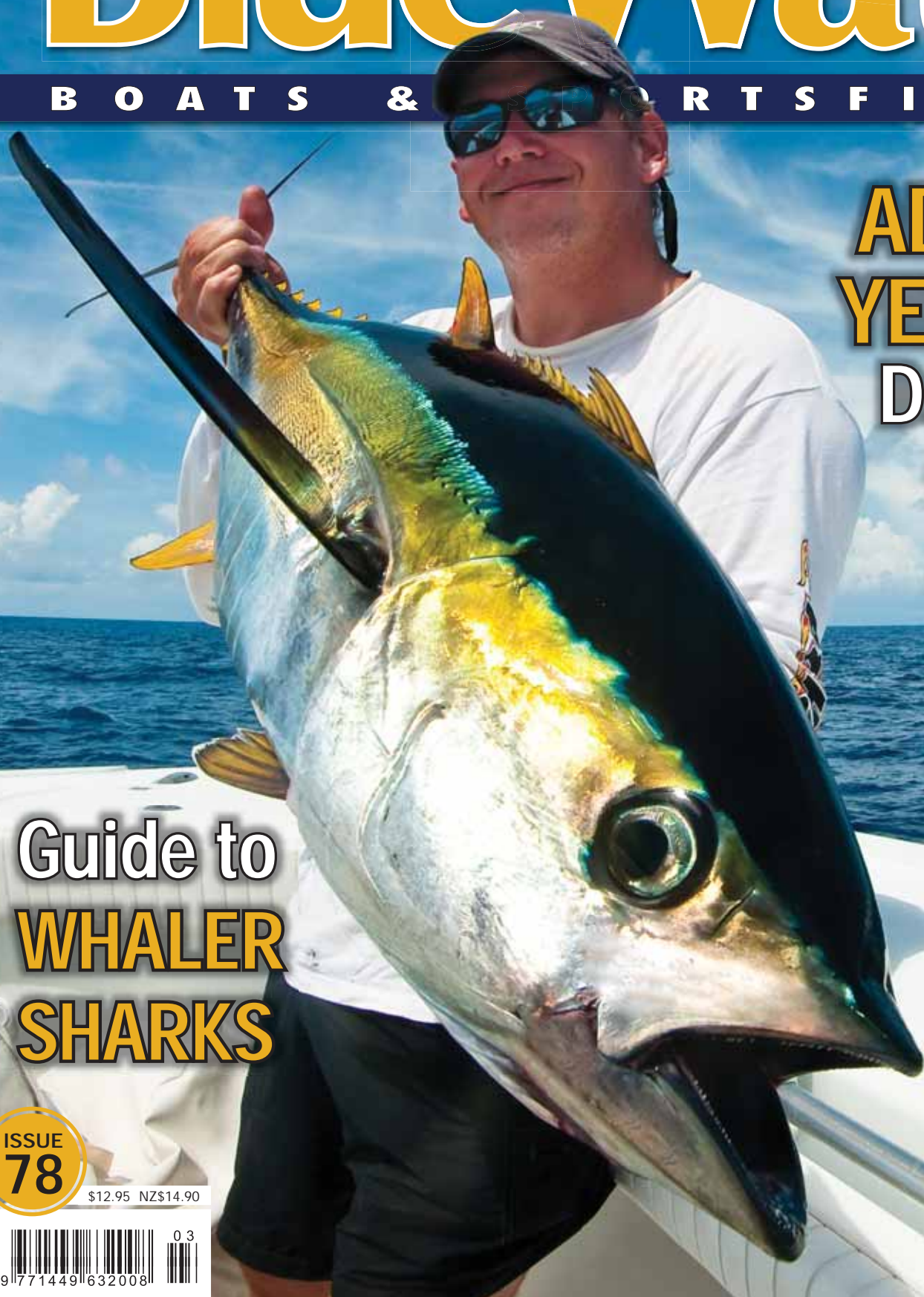

Tagging Report

A NEW report on fish tagged between 2006 and 2008 is now available to download from the I&I NSW website. The report was written by Dr Julian Pepperell and it details some interesting recaptures over the period, when 27,614 fish were tagged and 374 fish were recaptured. The report also includes some interesting maps of striped marlin and southern bluefin tuna recaptures recorded since the start of the program. These maps help to demonstrate any trends in fish movements. For example, the striped marlin map highlights apparent directed movement along the NSW coast and out towards possible spawning grounds located wide off southern Queensland.

This regular newsletter aims to keep participants in the tagging program updated with interesting recaptures and general news on the program.
