## WINE GRAPE PROCESSING INDUSTRY ACT 1979

## ORDER UNDER SECTION 6

Specified Grape Varieties, or Must from these Varieties to be Controlled Wine Grapes for the Year Commencing 1st January, 1988.

I, JACK ROWLAND HALLAM, Minister for Agriculture for the State of New South Wales, being the Minister administering the Wine Grape Processing Industry Act 1979, in pursuance of section 6 (1) (a) of the Act, do, by this Order, declare:

- (i) that on and from 1st January, 1988, wine grapes of the varieties Sultana (also known as Sultanina and Thompson Seedless), Merbein Seedless, and Muscat Gordo Blanco (also known as Gordo and Muscat of Alexandria), picked within the Shires of Wentworth, Balranald and Wakool, shall be controlled wine grapes; and
- (ii) must produced from those grapes shall be controlled must.
