

## STOCK (CHEMICAL RESIDUES) ACT 1975

## ORDER

## DECLARING CERTAIN SPECIES TO BE STOCK

I, IAN M. ARMSTRONG, Minister for Agriculture and Rural Affairs, pursuant to the powers conferred on me by section 3 of the Stock (Chemical Residues) Act 1975, hereby revoke the Order published in Government Gazette No. 165 of 12 December 1975, and declare that the animal species listed in the Schedule hereto are stock for the purposes of the Act.

**SCHEDULE**

Antelopes  
Birds  
Camelids  
Deer  
Fish  
Horses  
Rabbits.

For the purposes of this Order:

"antelopes" means cervines with cylindrical, annulated horns and lachrymal sinus;

"birds" means any members of the class Aves and their eggs;

"camelids" includes alpacas, camels, guanacos, llamas and vicunas;

"deer" means cervines with deciduous branching horns;

"fish" means any variety of marine, estuarine or freshwater fish, molluscs, crustaceans or other aquatic animal life forms, including their young, fry and spawn;

"horses" means any members of the family Equidae.
