NOTIFICATION OF THE WHOLE OF NEW SOUTH WALES AS A
TUBERCULOSIS IMPENDING FREE AREA

Notification No. 1430

I, JACK ROWLAND HALLAM, Minister for Agriculture for the State of New South Wales, pursuant to section 11A of the Stock Diseases Act 1923, revoke the Notification published in Government Gazette No. 79 of 6th June, 1975, and declare the whole of New South Wales to be a Protected Area as regards the disease Tuberculosis in cattle, and to be known as the "New South Wales Tuberculosis Impending Free Area".
