

# ROCK FISHING SAFETY

## Don't put your life on the line

- ✓ WEAR LIGHT CLOTHES AND NEVER FISH ALONE
- ✓ WEAR THE CORRECT FOOTWEAR – NON SLIP SOLES



- ✓ LIFE VEST IS BEST



Never fish in exposed areas during rough seas, find a calmer spot



If someone is washed into the ocean, DON'T jump in after them



Look for available angel ring, life buoy or something that floats



Throw the life buoy, or something that floats, to the person in the water



Dial 112 on your mobile phone or go to get help.

**ALWAYS** check weather conditions and tides before going rock fishing
