STOCK DISEASES ACT 1923**PROCLAMATION No. 529****AMENDMENT OF RESTRICTIONS ON THE INTRODUCTION OF PIGS INTO NEW SOUTH WALES
FROM QUEENSLAND, WESTERN AUSTRALIA AND THE NORTHERN TERRITORY**

(L.S.) P.R. SINCLAIR, *Governor*.

I, Rear Admiral PETER ROSS SINCLAIR, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of the provisions of section 11B of the Stock Diseases Act 1923, hereby amend Stock Diseases Proclamation No. 502 published in the Government Gazette No. 41 of 26th February 1988 as follows:

(a) by omitting clause 2(a), and inserting:

"(a) At the time of introduction, the person who introduces the pigs or who is in charge of the pigs presents a duly completed declaration and certificate to the Inspector at or nearest the place of introduction. The declaration and certificate must be in or to the effect of Schedule 1."

(b) by inserting clause 3.

"3. At the time of introduction the person must present the duly completed declaration and certificate with respect to pigs.

(c) by omitting Schedule 1 and inserting Schedule 1 hereto.

Introduction of Pigs into New South Wales from Queensland, Northern Territory and

I further declare that the pigs

- * (a) are being consigned directly to an abattoir for slaughter within seven (7) days, or;
- * (b) are from an accredited *Brucellosis* free herd or from a herd approved by the Chief, Division of Animal Industries, or;
- * (c) have been tested for *Brucella suis* Infection with negative results within the thirty (30) days before introduction into NSW, or;
- * (d) are from a herd south of the Tropic of Capricorn in Western Australia or the Northern Territory.
