This application form is for use by shareholders in the Abalone Fishery, Lobster Fishery, Ocean Trap & Line Fishery or endorsement holders in the Sea Urchin And Turban Shell Fishery who wish to apply to transfer quota between fishing businesses. The application is to be made jointly by the person who proposes to transfer quota (transferor) and the person who proposes to acquire that quota (transferee). This form is to be completed in full. The fee associated with this application can be paid by enclosing a cheque, money order, credit card payment form or a cash payment at your local regional office. #### Logbooks

All quota logbooks and catch records of the transferor/transferee, including any nil returns, must be up-to-date upon submission of the application. Abalone and lobster shareholders are required to submit a copy of their current monthly reconciliation form completed to the current date, signed and dated. Quota will be reconciled for the transferor/transferee prior to the transfer being completed. If logbook information is not up-to-date, your application will be refused.
