ORDER - Section 10

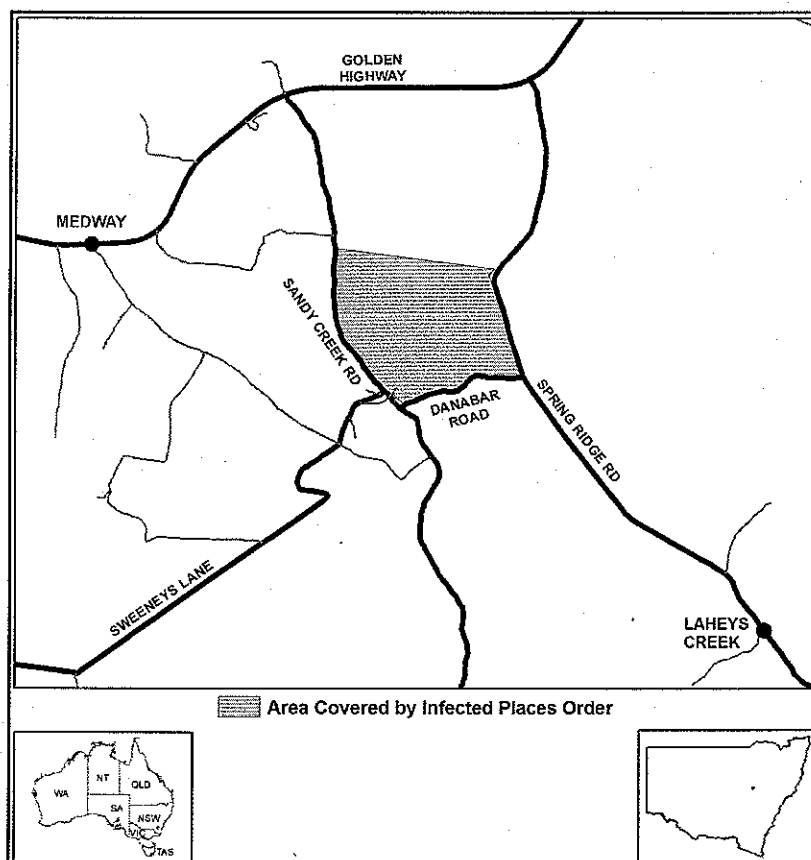
Declaration of Infected Place

I, Stephen Elliott Dunn, Deputy Chief Veterinary Officer, with the powers the Minister has delegated to me under section 67 of the *Animal Diseases (Emergency Outbreaks) Act 1991* ("the Act") and pursuant to section 10 of that Act on the basis that I reasonably suspect the area specified in Schedule 1 to be infected with the emergency animal disease Swine influenza:

1. revoke the order declared under section 10 of the Act titled "Order – Section 10 Declaration of Infected Place" dated 3 August 2009;
2. declare the area described in Schedule 1, which is within the State of New South Wales, ("Danabar"), to be an infected place
3. declare that the classes of animals, animal products, fodder, fittings or vehicles to which this order applies are those described in Schedule 2

SCHEDULE 1

The area, located within the area administered by Warrumbungle Shire Council, shown as highlighted in the map below and as described below:



The area bounded by the line commencing at the junction of Danabar Road and Sandy Creek Road, thence northerly along Sandy Creek Road for approximately 2650 metres to a point where a fence-line, running in from the east along a Crown Road, meets the eastern side of Sandy Creek Road, thence easterly along the fence-line to where it meets Spring Ridge Road (also known as Laheys Creek Road), thence southerly along Spring Ridge Road to its junction with Danabar Road, thence westerly along Danabar Road to the point of commencement.

SCHEDULE 2

Class of animals

All pigs (porcine).

Class of animal products

All animal products from pigs (porcine).


Class of fodder and fittings

All fodder and fittings from, or used in connection with, pigs (porcine).

Class of vehicles

All vehicles that have been used in connection with any of the classes of animals, animal products, fodder or fittings described in this Schedule.

**Notice to owner or person in charge or person in apparent control of property within
the area known as Infected Place 'Sandy Creek'**

Service of this Order on you is deemed to be written notice (pursuant to section 14 of the *Animal Diseases (Emergency Outbreaks) Act 1991*) that the above Order has been made declaring the area described in the above Schedule to be an infected place ("Danabar").

The movement of all persons, pigs, pig products, pig fodder, pig fittings and vehicles into, within or out of the Infected Place is prohibited, unless:

- authorised by a permit issued by an inspector, and
- made through an entry or exit point or points specified in a notice issued by an inspector.

Substantial penalties apply for breaches of these movement restrictions.

The Order remains in force until further notice.
