



## SCHEDULE OF COMMERCIAL FISHING FEES AND CHARGES

The following schedule of fees is effective from 1 July 2009. From 1 July 2010 some fees may increase in line with the consumer price index (CPI).

All Regulation Clause numbers are from the *Fisheries Management (General) Regulation 2002* unless otherwise specified.

When submitting any application that attracts an application fee, please include a cheque for the fee with your application form. Alternatively, you may make payment at your local regional office, or via the web (refer to details specified on application form). Note that applications not accompanied by an application fee, or applications with the wrong fee will not be accepted.
