

EXOTIC DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACT 1991

ORDER - Section 21

Declaration of control area – State of New South Wales

I, BRUCE MORGAN CHRISTIE, with the powers the Minister has delegated to me under section 67 of the *Exotic Diseases of Animals Act 1991* and pursuant to section 21 of that Act and being of the opinion that it is reasonably necessary for the purpose of preventing the spread of the exotic disease Equine influenza, do hereby declare:

1. the area specified in Schedule 1 to be a control area; and
2. that the classes of animals and animal products to which this order applies are those specified in Schedule 2 which have originated from the control area.

The whole of the State of New South Wales.

SCHEDULE 2

Classes of animals

Horses, mules, donkeys and other animals in the Equidae family.

Classes of animal products

Animal products from horses, mules, donkeys and other animals in the Equidae family.
