RICHGRO ROGOR INSECTICIDE
PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 100 g/L dimethoate as their only active constituent.

CRG SYSTEX INSECTICIDE

SUPERWAY DIMETHOATE 300 SYSTEMIC INSECTICIDE
PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 300 g/L dimethoate as their only active constituent.

PHARMACHEMICAL MALDISON 50 INSECTICIDE

DAVID GRAYS MALATHION GARDEN SPRAY
PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 500 g/L maldison as their only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Situation	Pest	Rate
Home gardens and nurseries Ornamental flowers.	Australian plague locust (<i>Chortoicetes terminifera</i>)	<u>100 g/L dimethoate products:</u> Apply at a rate of 30mL product in 10L water.
Home gardens Vegetables, fruit trees & lawns.		<u>300 g/L dimethoate products:</u> Apply at a rate of 10mL product in 10L water.
		<u>500 g/L maldison products:</u> Apply at a rate of 20mL product in 10L water.

Critical Use Comments:

Application

- Apply via hand held spray equipment to locusts when they appear and re-apply as required.
- Areas to be sprayed MUST be vacated by all persons other than the person undertaking spraying.

Preparing and using the spray – including Personal Protective Equipment

- Users MUST read and follow all current label directions prior to use, in particular that appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (as advised under the section titled "Safety Directions" on the relevant product label) is worn when preparing and using the spray.
- Users should wash hands and all clothing following use.

Product storage

- Users **MUST** read and follow all label directions regarding product storage (as advised under the section titled "Storage & Disposal" on the relevant product label). In particular that products are to be kept locked up and out of the reach of children.

Re-entering treated areas following application

- Garden beds, shrubs etc. - it is recommended that persons should not enter treated garden beds, shrub areas etc. until the spray has dried.
- Lawn areas - it is recommended that lawn areas sprayed not be re-entered until 12 hours after application.

Additional information:

- Users should obtain and read a copy of the NSW Agriculture fact-sheet titled "*Plague locust control for the home gardener and nursery areas*".

Withholding Period for edible crops:

DO NOT PICK/HARVEST FRUIT AND VEGETABLES FOR 7 DAYS AFTER APPLICATION.

Jurisdiction:

NSW only.

Additional Conditions:

This Permit provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with ALL instructions on its label.

Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.
