Total Allowable Catch Determinations

Background

A new Total Allowable Catch (TAC) determination is required to be made for the annual commercial fishing period 1 May 2021 to 30 April 2022 for the following quota species:

Ocean Trawl Fishery:

- tiger flathead
- bluespotted flathead
- silver trevally
- Eastern school whiting and stout whiting (combined)

Ocean Hauling Fishery (purse seine):

- Australian sardine
- blue mackerel
- yellowtail scad

Ocean Trap and Line Fishery:

- bass grouper
- gemfish
- pink ling
- blue-eye trevalla
- hapuku
- bigeye ocean perch
