## Catchment Management Authorities



There are thirteen Catchment Management Authorities (CMAs) in New South Wales, eight of which are located within the Murray Darling Basin and are the partners in the 'Wetlands on Farms' project. These eight are the Western, Lower Murray Darling, Murray, Murrumbidgee, Lachlan, Central West, Namoi and Border Rivers-Gwydir Catchment Management Authorities.

The role of a CMA is to ensure that regional communities have a significant say in how natural resources are managed in their catchments. CMAs are locally driven organisations with local board members who report directly to the NSW Minister for Environment, Climate Change.

CMAs are the primary means for the delivery of funding from the NSW and Australian Governments to help land managers improve and restore the natural resources of their State. They work in partnership with the community and community groups, Local Government, State Government agencies and industry.

#### *Key roles*

- **Planning and Investment** - the preparation and delivery of Catchment Action Plans (CAP) and managing incentive programs to implement these plans.
- **Native vegetation** - responsible for administering and managing native vegetation consents under the Native Vegetation Act 2003 such as Property Vegetation Plans.
- **Water** – help communities make decisions on water management and manage environmental water licenses.
- **On-ground works** – undertake or facilitate on-ground NRM works (on public or private land) for the purpose of catchment improvement and manage soil conservation projects.
- **Community engagement** – assist landholders to undertake sustainable management practices, provide technical advice and support, consult Aboriginal communities on the Catchment Action Plan (CAP) and provide other community information and support.
