

Assistance for primary producers affected by bushfire

For those in declared Local Government Areas as a result of bushfires, the following assistance is available.

GRANTS



Special Disaster Grants of up to \$75,000

Available to primary producers who have suffered direct damage to, or loss of, assets and infrastructure.

To help pay for immediate clean-up, reinstatement and repairs to infrastructure.

NSW Small Business and Non-Profit Organisation Grant of up to \$50,000

Available to small business and not-for-profits direct damage to premises or equipment.



To help pay for clean up, removal and disposal expenses, repair bills, safety inspections, hiring of equipment or replacing stock.

LOANS



Working Capital Loans up to \$50,000 or Special Disaster Loans up to \$500,000

Available to those who have suffered damage to assets or property, or significant loss of income (such as reduced trade or visitor numbers due to road closures or evacuations).

To help pay for essential expenses, business related bills, rebuilding and repairing damaged assets.
