Total Allowable Catch Determination - Ocean Trap & Line Fishery

NSW Ocean Trap & Line Fishery – 1 May 2021 to 30 April 2022

The Deputy Director General, DPI Fisheries, as the delegate of the Secretary of the Department of Regional NSW, has made the following Total Allowable Catch (TAC) determinations for the line east sector of Ocean Trap and Line Fishery for the fishing period 1 May 2021 to 30 April 2022.

Quota species	TAC determination (kg)	Fishing Period
Bigeye ocean perch	21,100	1 May 2021 - 30 April 2022
Blue-eye trevalla	30,000	1 May 2021 - 30 April 2022
Gemfish	7,100	1 May 2021 - 30 April 2022
Hapuku	5,200	1 May 2021 - 30 April 2022
Pink ling	67,700	1 May 2021 - 30 April 2022

The Total Allowable Fishing (TAF) Committee has made the following TAC determination for Bass grouper in the Ocean Trap and Line Fishery for the fishing period 1 May 2021 to 30 April 2022.

Quota species	TAC determination (kg)	Fishing Period
Bass grouper	6,100	1 May 2021 - 30 April 2022
