Fisheries Management Act 1994 Cl.119 Fisheries Management (General) Regulation 2019

This application form is to be used by the holder of a fishing boat licence who wishes to notify the Secretary of the NSW Department of Industry of identification details for a boat to be used under the authority of a fishing boat licence, to notify of any change to the identification details of a boat used under the authority of a fishing boat licence, or notify the Minister that a boat used under the authority of the fishing boat licence has been disposed of, destroyed or lost at sea. This form is to be completed in full.

Note: If the application relates to replacing a boat used for ocean trawl prawning, please complete Lic form 12.

<p>Companies and Partnerships If the application is made by a partnership, all partners must sign the application. If the application is made by a company, the application must be signed by two Directors or a Director and the Secretary, unless the company is a sole Director company and only has a single director.</p> <p>Notifying of modifications or changes The holder of a licence must notify NSW DPI Fisheries if a boat is modified and the modification affects the identification details specified in the boat licence, before using the boat for declared commercial fishing boat activities, or otherwise within 7 days of the modification.</p> <p>Maximum licence specification The boat used under the authority of the fishing boat licence must not exceed the maximum length or maximum hull units specified in the licence.</p> <p>Disposal of licensed fishing boats The holder of a licence must notify NSW DPI Fisheries, in writing, within 30 days of a licensed fishing boat being disposed of, destroyed or lost at sea. Fishing boat licence fees remain payable while a licence does not have a boat specified.</p> <p>Boat details verification for licensed fishing boats In accordance with Clause 124 of the <i>Fisheries Management (General) Regulation 2019</i>, the dimensions of a boat are to be determined in accordance with the National Standard for Commercial Vessels. The measured length of the boat is taken to be the measured length of the boat as specified on the most recent certificate of survey for the boat.
