Total Allowable Catch Determination - NSW Ocean Trawl Fishery

Ocean Trawl Fishery – 1 May 2020 to 30 April 2021

The Total Allowable Fishing (TAF) Committee has made the following Total Allowable Catch (TAC) determinations for the NSW Ocean Trawl Fishery for the fishing period of 1 May 2020 to 30 April 2021.

The Department of Primary Industries will allocate quota to shareholders for the corresponding ocean trawl species prior to 1 May 2020.

| Quota species | TAC determination (kg) | Fishing Period |
|--------------------------|------------------------|----------------------------|
| Bluespotted flathead | 108,100 | 1 May 2020 - 30 April 2021 |
| Tiger flathead | 166,900 | 1 May 2020 - 30 April 2021 |
| Silver Trevally | 26,800 | 1 May 2020 - 30 April 2021 |
| Trawl Whiting (combined) | 898,100 | 1 May 2020 - 30 April 2021 |

When the TAF Committee makes a TAC determination, the Committee provides a Determination Report that explains the reasons for their determination.
