Ocean Trawl Fishery – 1 May 2021 to 30 April 2022

The Total Allowable Fishing (TAF) Committee has made the following Total Allowable Catch (TAC) determinations for the Ocean Trawl Fishery for the fishing period 1 May 2021 to 30 April 2022.

Quota species	TAC determination (kg)	Fishing Period
Bluespotted flathead	108,100	1 May 2021 - 30 April 2022
Silver Trevally	20,000	1 May 2021 - 30 April 2022
Trawl Whiting (combined)	1,066,000	1 May 2021 - 30 April 2022
