The Deputy Director General, DPI Fisheries, as the delegate of the Secretary of the Department of Regional NSW, has made the following Total Allowable Catch (TAC) determinations for the line east sector of NSW Ocean Trap and Line Fishery for the fishing period 1 May 2020 to 30 Aril 2021.

The Department of Primary Industries will allocate quota to shareholders for the corresponding ocean haul species prior to 1 May 2020.
