## Closed Waters

The whole of the waters within the area bounded by the line commencing at the south eastern extremity of Shark Island ( Pt Stephens), thence east to the intersection of the coordinates $32^{\circ} 45.000^{\prime} \mathrm{S}$ and $152^{\circ} 14.200^{\prime} \mathrm{E}$, thence north east to the intersection of the coordinates $32^{\circ} 33.000^{\prime} \mathrm{S}$ and $152^{\circ} \mathbf{2 5 . 4 0 0}$ ' $E$, thence east north east to the intersection of the coordinates $32^{\circ} 28.300^{\prime} \mathrm{S}$ and $152^{\circ} 35.000^{\prime} \mathrm{E}$, thence north west to the eastern most extremity of Sugarloaf Point (Seals Rocks), thence south along the mean high water mark to Yagon Gibber, thence due east from the eastern most extremity of Yagon Gibber to the 10 fathom depth contour, thence generally south along the 10 fathom depth contour (inside Broughton Island, Inner Island and Dry Rock etc) until due east o the most easterly extremity of Yacaaba Head, thence due west to the eastern most extremity of Yacaaba Head, thence generally south south west along the mean high water mark to the southern most extremity of Yacaaba Point, thence south to the Northern extremity of Tomaree Point, thence generally south south east along the mean high water mark to the point of commencement.
