Prevention, Preparedness, Response and Recovery



- Adopt a One Health approach to managing terrestrial and aquatic animal pests and diseases
- Prioritise terrestrial and aquatic animal pests and diseases using a risk based framework
- Underpin legislation and policy decisions with evidence and risk based approaches
- Prevent and prepare for high-risk emergency animal disease (EAD) outbreaks
- Respond to suspect and confirmed animal biosecurity hazards
- Work in partnership to build industry capacity and capability to prevent and manage animal biosecurity risks




Continuous improvement
