Department of Regional NSW will not disclose your personal information to anybody without your consent, unless authorised by law or as indicated in this statement or the Privacy Collection Notice.

The provision of this information is required for the purpose of processing your request under the *Game and Feral Animal Control Act 2002*. If you choose not to provide the requested information, the Department of Regional NSW may not be able to process your request.

The information is stored securely on Amazon Web Services (AWS) and will be destroyed after 7 years if the account is inactive.
