- Chair opened the meeting at 9:30am and welcomed Council members.

2. Review of Agenda

NOTED:

3. Review, Declarations and update Register of Interests

There were no declarations or updates to the Register of Interest.

4. Discussion - Social and Economic report prepared by Professor Barclay and Government initial response.

NOTED:

- The Economic analysis and Social and Economic monitoring report prepared by Professor Barclay and that it was very hard to comprehend;
- The recommendations of the report:
 - Establish a social and economic framework for NSW commercial fisheries as a matter of high priority and urgency;
 - Investigate further whether the levels of commercial debt incurred as a result of the Business Adjustment Program are damaging industry viability, and if so, consider interventions to alleviate that debt;
 - Consider instituting protections from changes to resource access in commercial fisheries management; and
 - Investigate more effective ways of doing consultation and policy development.
- The NSW Government initial response to the recommendations of the report.

AGREE: CommFish supported:

• The Government's initial responses to the recommendations of the report.

ACTION 15.1: NSW DPI:

1. To work to implement the actions arising from the NSW Government's initial response to the recommendations of the report.

5. Presentation and Discussion – Economic and Social indicator monitoring proposal

A presentation on the BDO EconSearch Economic and Social indicator monitoring proposal was presented to CommFish NSW.

NOTED:

- For this to be successful industry needs to engage and provide input into the social and economic monitoring of NSW commercial fisheries;
- The proposal includes talking to commercial fishers to gain quality data and insight;
- Future benefits for monitoring, will include the provision of data for the development of harvest strategies; to target maximum economic yield and demonstrate the economic contribution of commercial fisheries to NSW and its regions;
- A communication strategy will be key to the success of this monitoring;
- Consideration to fund proposal from the Commercial Fishing Trust Fund;
- The monitoring could potentially provide industry with benefits when seeking future financing opportunities; and
- The Inland Fishery will also be included in the proposed social and economic monitoring framework.

AGREE: CommFish supported:

• The social and economic monitoring proposal put forward by BDO EconSearch and recommends that they be engaged to conduct the research as a matter of urgency; and

• The proposal being funded from the Commercial Fishing Trust Fund

ACTION 15.2: NSW DPI:

- 1. Engage BDO EconSearch to deliver the Economic and Social indicator monitoring;
- 2. To recommend funding for the proposal from the Commercial Fishing Trust Fund; and
- 3. Provide CommFish NSW with a balance of the Commercial Fishing Trust Fund.

6. Letter from the Chair – Ministerial Fisheries Advisory Council (MFAC)

NOTED:

- That the discussion held by CommFish NSW at their August 2020 meeting on several initiatives proposed by MFAC Commercial fishery member to invest in the future of commercial fishing has also been presented at the MFAC meeting on 4 September 2020;
- It is key to get the timing for such investment right; and
- The data to support many of the initiatives are not yet available.

AGREE: CommFish supported;

- The proposal in principal to invest in the future of commercial fishing; and
- Delaying the initiatives until further real data can be provided and the current economic climate becomes more stable.

ACTION 15.3: The Chair is to write to the Chair of MFAC advising that whilst CommFish is supportive of the initiatives the timing for such investment should be revisited at a later date.
