

**PERMIT UNDER SECTION 37
FISHERIES MANAGEMENT ACT 1994**

In accordance with the provisions of Section 37(1)(e) of the *Fisheries Management Act 1994* (the Act), **Mr Steven Everson (Reg No 780721) of Palmers Island NSW, and any person of the class specified below**, are authorised to use the method specified below to take and possess fish, subject to the conditions of this permit.

Class of persons

Any person who holds an Estuary General category one hauling endorsement as prescribed in the Fisheries Management (Estuary General Share Management Plan) Regulation 2006.

Method

A hauling net (general purpose) as prescribed in Clause 17 of the Fisheries Management (Estuary General Share Management Plan) Regulation 2006 with a maximum mesh size in the centre piece (of the bunt) of 65 mm.

Conditions

1. Unless sooner suspended or cancelled this permit will expire on **30 June 2019**.
2. This permit is only valid while the permit holder or any other person authorised by this permit has a current commercial fishing licence.
3. The permit holder and any other person authorised by this permit must abide by any instruction, relating to the operation of this permit, given by an Officer of the New South Wales Department of Primary Industries (NSW DPI).

- Other than where expressly stated, this permit does not authorise fishing activities in contravention of the Act or any Regulation under this Act.
- This permit may be varied, suspended or cancelled at any time by a duly delegated officer of NSW DPI.
- Failure to comply with any of the conditions of this permit may result in the variation or cancellation of this permit and prosecution under the Act.
- The issue of this permit in no way implies or guarantees future rights in any fishery beyond the date of expiry of this permit.
