Revised version of the *General Standards for Exhibiting Animals in New South Wales*.

Dear Exhibitor

The Department would like to advise that the revised version of the *General Standards for Exhibiting Animals in New South Wales* published in September 2015 on its website at:

These standards update the previous edition to include changes to Clause 20 as per Circular 2014/03 that was sent out in May 2014. The primary aim of the changes was to clarify that animals cannot be ordinarily kept in small off-exhibit enclosures and rotated through exhibit sized enclosures for a short period of time in order to reset the 90 day limit on the maintenance of animals in medium term holding enclosures.

The revised edition also updates references to the Department and to the head of the Department, i.e. to the Secretary.
