Section F: Native game bird hunting

To qualify to hunt native game birds in NSW you must have completed the Waterfowl Identification Test (WIT). You can supply your WIT number to DPI at a later time if you do not already have one.

I have attached a copy of my WIT certificate, or the front and back of my Victorian game hunting licence card that has my WIT number printed on it.

DPI will verify your WIT number with the Victorian Game Management Authority. This may take one week or more.

Section G: Special requirements for visitors

NSW Restricted (Visitor's) Game Hunting Licences are issued for one (1) year only.

- If you intend to use a firearm to hunt game and feral animals in NSW, you **must** contact the NSW Police Force Firearms Registry for an Overseas Visitors Safari Tour/Hunting Permit **before** you submit this application with the NSW Department of Primary Industries. To qualify for this permit, you must hunt in a specified organised safari and with a guide who has been granted a Safari Tour Permit, also issued by the NSW Police Force Firearms Registry.
- Please contact the NSW Police Force Firearms Registry on **+61 2 1300 362 562** before you submit this application.
- When hunting on declared public land your guide must hold a NSW Restricted Game Hunting Licence that is either a Standard or a Guide Licence. When hunting on private land your guide must hold either a NSW Restricted or General Game Hunting Licence that is either a Standard or a Guide Licence. You must be **accompanied by your guide at all times** when hunting in NSW.
- A NSW Restricted (Visitor's) Game Hunting Licence authorises you to hunt game animals on declared public land and private land with permission in NSW.
- A NSW Restricted (Visitor's) Game Hunting Licence does not supersede, override, or preclude you from the requirements of other hunting, firearm, safety, and animal welfare Laws and Regulations currently in place in NSW.
