 - iii. the bees are kept in a cage made of secure insect-proof material with holes smaller than 2 millimeters x 2 millimeters, or if any slots are longer than 2 millimeters, there are no wider than 1 millimeter; and
 - iv. the bees will not remain in the State for longer than 24 hours.

 - iii. the bees are kept in a cage made of secure insect-proof material with holes smaller than 2 millimeters x 2 millimeters, or if any slots are longer than 2 millimeters, they are no wider than 1 millimeter, and
 - iv. after packing, the bees will be imported directly from the location at which they were packed to the location specified by the Department.
