This form is to be completed when applying for a permit under section 37 of the *Fisheries Management Act 1994* (the Act) to authorise the take of carp or yabbies in accordance with Inland Restricted Fishery Class A: yabby and carp (Transferable) or Class B: Carp only (Transferable) or Class D: Carp only (Non Transferable) endorsement.

To avoid delays or refusal, this form should be completed in full with supporting information and contact details attached. It is important that all information is provided, as any change in dates, species or location will render the application and/or the permit invalid.

Applications will be considered on merit and the issue of a permit is not guaranteed. Factors considered include the proposed method/s, quantities and sustainability of the resource. Please allow up to 10 days for the processing of the application.
