

FORMAT OF NEW SOUTH WALES IDENTIFICATION CODES

The format is eight characters comprising two letters and six numbers.

Property identification code (PIC) format for properties/holdings, feedlots, showgrounds, travelling stock reserves, public land

- 1st character: State code. The default state code is 'N' (for NSW).
- 2nd character: Check letter, between A and K. The check digit is calculated according to an algorithm, allowing computer programs to automatically check whether the data entry is correct and the code is valid.
- 3rd and 4th characters: District number. This number identifies the former Rural Lands Protection District in which the property principally lies.
- 5th to 8th characters: Property number, assigned in sequential order from '0001' to '9999'.

PIC format for saleyards and abattoirs

- 1st character: State code, as above.
- 2nd character: Check letter, as above.
- 3rd and 4th characters: Double nine, ie '99'. This distinguishes saleyards and abattoirs, where stock is only temporarily held, from all other properties.
- 5th and 6th characters: District number, as above.
- 7th and 8th characters: Establishment number, assigned in sequential order from '01' to '09' for saleyards, and '11' to '19' for abattoirs.

Agent identification code format

- 1st character: State code, as above.
- 2nd character: Check letter, as above.
- 3rd and 4th characters: Double nought, ie '00'. This distinguishes agent codes from all other identification codes.
- 5th and 6th characters: District number, as above.
- 7th and 8th characters: Agent number, assigned in sequential order from '01' to '99'.

District code format

- 1st character: State code, as above.
- 2nd character: Check letter, as above.
- 3rd and 4th characters: District number, as above.
- 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th characters: Four noughts, ie '0000'. This signifies that the code applies to the whole district, not an individual property.
