(4) Subclause (3) applies not only to supply effected directly but also to supply effected indirectly by means of an agent or intermediary.)

Date of first examination by a competent person _____

Date of first veterinary examination _____

Each animal must be examined by a competent person within 24 hours of arrival, and at least daily thereafter, until it is supplied for animal research.

Within 3 days of arrival, each animal must be given a comprehensive clinical examination by a veterinary surgeon and must be given any vaccination or treatment, including the humane killing of the animal, considered necessary by a veterinary surgeon, to ensure that no animal that is injured, sick or unsuitable is supplied for animal research.

Immediate veterinary attention must be sought for any animal that shows any of the following signs: nasal discharge, ocular discharge, coughing, vomiting, diarrhoea, convulsions, lameness, inability to stand or walk, bleeding.

The results of any examination of the animal, details of any vaccination or treatment given and (if the animal dies) the date on which it died and the cause of death must be entered on the record of the animal.
