

Abalone viral ganglioneuritis (AVG) Important Information for Consumers

Help protect NSW abalone stocks

Imported abalone can potentially pose a risk to NSW abalone stocks. To help reduce this risk please:

- Throw abalone shells, gut and any leftover abalone waste in the bin – do not discard any abalone remains in waterways.
- Do not use abalone gut as bait in NSW - it is illegal and there is a fishing closure prohibiting this activity.

外來鮑魚對新南威爾士州的鮑魚資源構成了潛在的威脅。

你可以幫助減少這種風險。請你：

- 將包括鮑魚殼、內臟和其他下水在內的鮑魚廢棄物放入垃圾箱處理。不要直接把它們丟棄於水道中。
- 不要在新南威爾士州使用鮑魚內臟作魚餌。這是違法行為，同時目前的禁漁規定也不允許這樣做。
