

## Zinc Phosphide for Mouse Control in Paddocks

When dealing with high numbers of mice, the most effective mice management strategy for landholders is to reduce the availability of food and shelter, in combination with the use of approved rodenticides as required.

Zinc phosphide is the currently registered chemical for controlling mice in paddocks. In NSW, zinc phosphide bait products are not restricted, and can be purchased directly from rural resellers.

Since mouse numbers started to rise in NSW in late 2020, the Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority (APVMA) has granted several emergency permits for baits containing zinc phosphide to control mice in a range of cropping situations.

In NSW, pesticides must be used in accordance with the label or APVMA permit instructions on a registered pesticide. In May 2021, a permit (PER90799) was issued to Grain Producers Australia for use of double dose (50g active/kg bait) zinc phosphide on grain, legume, canola, safflower and nut crops, as well as use on pasture.

This permit, which is in force from 7 May 2021 to 31 May 2022, is expected to greatly improve the effectiveness of using zinc phosphide to control mice.

It is important for landholders to read the permit (<u>PER90799</u>) to ensure they apply the product in a safe manner and only use the approved products listed below.
